After much deliberation it was decided that Troy DeMolay chapter would move its regular meetings to the first Sunday of each month at 12:30pm.

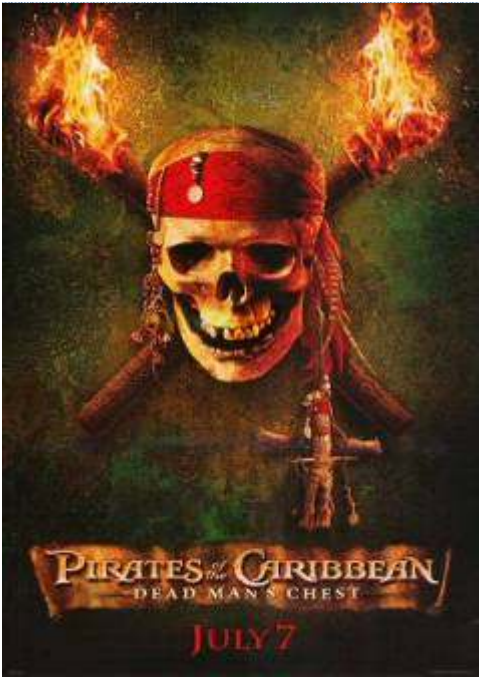
**Starting with the next meeting on October 1 brunch will be served starting at 12:00pm. Bring your entire family to share in fellowship on this special day each meeting.**

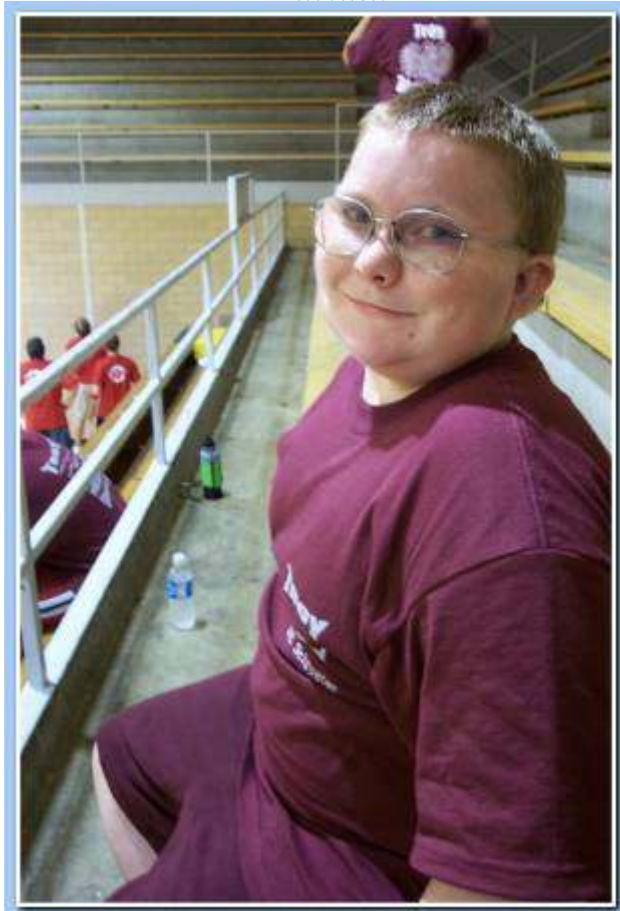

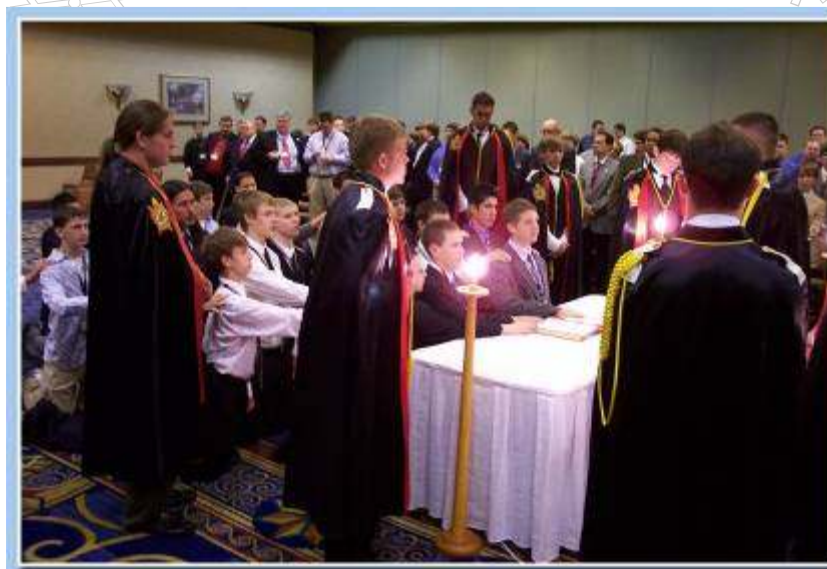
